## TIMSS and PIRLS 2011 Description of the TIMSS and PIRLS 2011 Data Files

In 2011, each national center entered the TIMSS and PIRLS data into the data files listed below. At the fourth grade, teacher and student background (questionnaire) data files included a filter variable to allow for the display of variables according to each country's participation in PIRLS, TIMSS, or both. At the eighth grade, each questionnaire consisted of a single file and had a corresponding codebook/data file.
